City of St. Louis Park
Wood and Yard Waste Transfer Site Management

PROPOSALS: Proposals for the work described below will be received by the office of the City Clerk, City of St. Louis Park City Hall, 5005 Minnetonka Boulevard, St. Louis Park, Minnesota, until **10 a.m. on June 4, 2025**, at which time the bids will be opened and publicly read in the Community Room.

WORK DESCRIPTION: The City of St. Louis Park is seeking bids for management of the city's wood and yard waste transfer site. This contract would include general upkeep and staffing of site, wood waste disposal and handling, and yard waste transfer; and optional activities: street sweeping and soil hauling, landscape mulch supply, and compost supply.

This is a three-year contract for 2026 – 2028.

COMPLETION OF WORK: Work will begin at the site on January 1, 2026 and terminate on December 31, 2028.
