

2026 Grease Producer License

Any commercial or manufacturing business generating animal or vegetable fats, oils, and greases (referred to as FOG), through food preparation, service, manufacturing, or other products are not permitted to discharge such substances into the city sanitary sewer system without first obtaining a Grease Producers License or Provisional Grease Producers license from the city.

Enclosed is the 2026 Grease Producers License application. Payment is due at the time the application is submitted. Checks should be payable to the "City of St. Louis Park", or we accept Visa, MasterCard, Discover and American Express.

All businesses are issued a license for the calendar year. The license is effective from the date of issuance through December 31st of the year in which the license was issued.

Upon successful review and evaluation, the city's licensing department shall approve the application and issue the appropriate license:

- 1) A Grease producers License shall be granted to FSE (food service establishments) and commercial/industrial businesses that have installed and maintained compliant grease interceptors or FOG control devices.
- 2) A Provisional Grease Producers License shall be granted to buildings that are required to be licensed but do not currently have a compliant grease interceptor. The provisional license fee covers the added cost of public sewer main cleaning as a result of added FOG accumulation.
