1: Identify the need and get started - completed



City staff:

- Define area, scope, budget and timing
- Understand community and businesses in the area
- Plan communication tools (website, email, etc.)

2: Collect data - completed



City staff review:

- Existing policy and plans
- Traffic and parking
- Survey and environmental
- Infrastructure condition
- Community input

You:

Help us understand how you navigate your neighborhood through questionnaires and online mapping tools



3: Design (June - October 2026)



City staff:
Create the preliminary design

Then you:
Give your feedback on the preliminary design

Then city staff:
Consider feedback and finalize the design

Then you:
View the final design and ask clarifying questions to prepare for the public hearing



4: Council review (December 2026)



City council:

Hear directly from staff and the community on the proposed project during the public hearing

You:

Speak directly to the city council ahead of them making a decision



5: Council decision (Dec. 2026)



The project plan is now finalized!



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
